This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This Corporation shall be a nonprofit corporation. The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is to give students at Florida International University breathalyzers so that alcohol levels may be measured prior to driving a vehicle, thus preventing possible deaths due to drinking and driving.
