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

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, this Florida not for profit corporation adopts the following amendments to its Articles of Incorporation:

Article III of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation, as filed with the *Florida Secretary of State* on October 1, 2009, is hereby amended to delete all language in Article III, and replace it with the following language:

- "3.1 The specific purpose of PC TRU, INC. is to educate within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. PC TRU, INC., also known as Policy Center To Reduce Unemployment, is incorporated under Florida Statutes Chapter 617 (Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act). Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities prohibited (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- 3.2 In the event of a winding up and dissolution of the Corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under section 501©(3) of the Internal revenue Code.
- 3.3 The Corporation's activities include but are not limited to:
- 3.3(a) The Corporation shall have and exercise all rights and powers as are or may be hereafter conferred on not-for-profit corporations pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and in accordance with other applicable law including Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, such as but not limited to the power to make contracts and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the

Corporation may determine; issue notes, bonds and other obligations except as prohibited by law; and otherwise have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect any or all of the purposes for which the Corporation is organized.

- 3.3(b) The Corporation will conduct its own surveys related to unemployment, review and compile data from reputable sources related to unemployment, and formulate policies designed to reduce unemployment in the United States. The Corporation's recommended policies for reducing unemployment and information related thereto will be available through the Corporation's Internet site as a part of the Corporation's mission of public education on unemployment.
- 3.3(c) The Corporation will work with employees (individuals, groups and unions), employers (corporations, partnerships and small businesses) and governmental bodies (municipal, county, state and national) to implement policies formulated under paragraph 3.2 to reduce unemployment without participating in any political campaign, or on behalf of any candidate for public office or any political party.
- 3.3(d) The Corporation's Internet site will provide multiple unemployment related blogs to obtain public opinion on causes of unemployment and means of reducing it as well as educating and encouraging a national dialogue on unemployment."

The date of adoption of the amendment was September 22, 2010.
