**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

ARTICLE I
NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation", is Family Christian Academy Parent Teacher Organization, Inc.

ARTICLE II
PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III
PURPOSES

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
