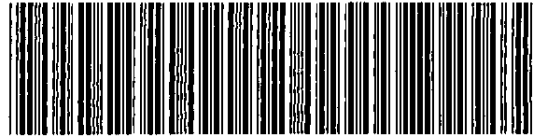

**Articles of Incorporation
of
Set Apart Outreach, Inc.**

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In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

Articles of Incorporation of Set Apart Outreach, Inc. The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Florida, do hereby certify:

Article 1: The name of the Corporation shall be **Set Apart Outreach, Inc.**

Article 2: The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is 1478 Beechfern Drive, Melbourne, Florida in the County of Brevard.

Article 3: Said Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Said Corporation's purpose(s) is to identify and address the critical needs (physical, emotional, and spiritual) of individuals and families in poor and distressed circumstances, with our emphasis being on women. To accomplish this said Corporation endeavors to provide available social resources and assistance, life skills education, and ministry. By building individuals and families we seek to prevent abuse and equip them to be viable and self-sufficient members of the community.

Article 4: The directors/officers shall be elected each year in accordance with the By-Laws of the Corporation.

Article 5: The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial directors/officers of the Corporation are as follows.

Article 6: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 3 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation.

Article 7: Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
