The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida do hereby certify:

First: The name of the Corporation shall be the Lakeview Middle School PTO, Inc.

Second: The place in the state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is the city of Winter Garden, Orange County, FL. The physical street and mailing address is 1200 W. Bay St. Winter Garden, FL 34787.

Third: Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
