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

AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION **FOR**

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2009 DEC 21 AM 9:56 SINGLE MOTHERS INFINITELY LOVE EXCELLENCE, I



The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes. In pursuit of these purposes, the corporation may also do any of the following:

To purchase, lease, own or otherwise acquire real estate, and to mortgage and encumber the same. To sell, contract for the sale and to convey real estate and interest therein.

To do any legal activity to the same extent a natural person might or could do as a principal or agent. To execute generally such powers as may be vested in a corporation under the non-profit corporation laws of the State of Florida.

The corporate mission is to work primarily with single women and single men with children so that they may connect with all community resources to enable the betterment of all families so affected. This includes community resources involved in providing housing facilities, those agencies in the community which are involved in helping to provide low cost food, and those agencies which assist in viable clothing for the children of these single parents. Recreation facilities of the community could also help these children become more socially adjusted to school and family involvements.

ARTICLE IX- DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

No person, firm, or corporation shall ever receive any dividends or profits from the undertaking of this corporation, and upon dissolution of this organization, all of its assets remaining after payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed to an organization or organizations which have qualified for exemption under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal Government, or to a State or Local government, for a public purpose, and none of the assets will be distributed to any member or officer of this corporation for private increment.

ARTICLE X- GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR OPERATIONS

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation will not carry on any other activities which are not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. This includes the regulations relating to the corporation in its public support of political candidates. The

corporation will not be involved in providing corporation assistance in obtaining voter support of any political candidate. No corporation financial support will be provided for any political party. No public remarks of support or degradation will be part of the activity sponsored by this corporation.
