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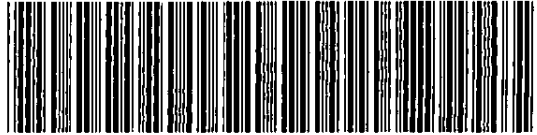

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

(A Not-for-Profit Corporation)

Be it known that we, the subscribers, do hereby associate ourselves as a body pursuant to the statute laws of the State of Florida regulating the formation and organization of corporations without capitol stock and the following are our Articles of Association:

Article 1: Name

The name of our corporation is REACHING OUR COMMUNITIES KIDS ASSOCIATION, INC

Article 2: Principal Location

The principal office of the association shall be maintained at 2841 Fowler Street, Fort Myers, FL 33901.

Article 3: Purpose

The Association is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including for such purposes of making and distributing to organization that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any educational, and charitable purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. To that end, the Association is empowered to hold any property, or any undivided interest therein without limitation as to the amount or value; to dispose of any such property and deal with the principal or the income in such manner as, in the judgment of the Board of Directors, will best promote the purposes of the Association, without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received. These Articles of Association, the By-Laws, or any applicable laws, to do any other act or thing incidental to or connect with the foregoing purposes or in advancement thereof, but not for the pecuniary profit or financial gain of its directors or officers except as permitted under Not-for-Profit Law.

The purpose of the Association is to promote interest amongst first generation, at risk, disadvantages students; to complete high school, and pursue a post secondary education. The R.O.C.K Association networks to provide tutoring, mentoring, an ambassador and summer program, lectures series, parent information sessions, scholarship opportunities, financial aid, and admissions workshops, as well as college tours. As a means to further public welfare; foster and promote communication, research and development to further community relations in order to support the students. The dissemination of technical, and educational information relating to the association; and the printing and publishing of documents, books, magazines, newspapers and pamphlets necessary or incidental to any of the above purposes.

No part of the net earnings of the association shall inure to the benefit of any member or officer of the organization, or any private individual, except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Association affecting one or more of its purposes. No member or officer of the Association, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the association. No substantial part of the activities of the association shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation. The Association shall not participate in or intervene in, the publication or distribution of statements, of any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Article 4: Governing Body

The Affairs of the Association shall be governed by a Board of Directors consisting of two Directors, and three to five community leaders as defined in the By-Laws.

Article 5: Directors

The qualification for directors and the manner of there admission shall be regulated by the by-laws. The Directors shall be elected for terms of three years by the members eligible to vote, according to the schedule prescribed in the By-Laws. Election of Directors shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations prescribed in the By-Laws. The Board shall meet twice a year at time and places provided in the By-Laws. The first meeting shall be called the Annual Meeting and the second shall be called the Second Meeting. Special meetings of the Board shall be called by the Board President upon written request of at least one-half of the Board as constituted. The following offices shall serve as the directors:

Assistant Director

Registered Agent

Article 8: Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the organization or the winding up of its affairs, the assets of the Association shall be distributed exclusively to on or more charitable, religious, or educational organizations which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may be hereafter amended. Any such assets not so disposed shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the Association is then located, exclusively for such purposes as said.

Article 9: Territory of Principal Location

The territory in which the principal location of the Association is to be conducted is the United States of America and its territories and possessions. But, the operations of the Association shall not be limited to such territory.

Article 10: Conflict of Interest Policy

This organization shall have a policy to protect the Association's interest, when it is contemplating entering into a transaction or arraignment that might benefit the private interest or an officer or director. Details of the policy are found in the Conflict of Interest Policy.

Article 11: By-Laws

The Board of Directors of this organization will utilize the By-Laws for the conduct of its business and the carrying out of the organizations purpose.

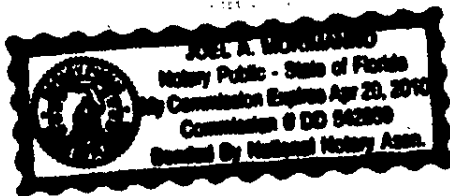
