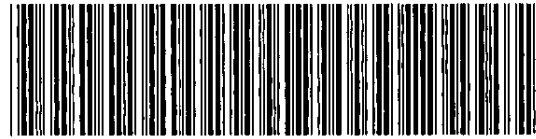

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: PFLAG-Tallahassee, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

1407 S. Meridian Street
Tallahassee, FL 32301

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

- a) to hold and manage property and funds for charitable and eleemosynary purposes, including the assistance and support of charitable and eleemosynary institutions, associations and undertakings.
- b) To provide a support system for families and friends of lesbians and gays in their effort to understand, accept, and support their children with love and pride.
- c) To provide education for individuals and the community at large on the nature of homosexuality.
- d) To support the full human rights and civil rights of lesbians and gays
- e) To speak out and act whenever necessary to defend and enhance those human rights and civil rights.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The government of the chapter shall be entrusted to the members of the chapter, who shall elect a President, Secretary and a Treasurer. The officers shall serve for a two-year term and may stand for re-election for at least one more term. Elections shall take place in the fall of odd-numbered years, on or about the second week in September.

Election of Officers – All chapter members in good standing shall have the right to one vote at the annual election meeting. No officer of the Chapter may serve more than two consecutive terms in the same position. The membership may establish a nominating committee to present nominees at the annual election. A member in good standing is a family or household or single person who has paid both the national and local chapter dues for the fiscal year.




