

SECTION I: MISSION, PURPOSE

The mission of Nonprofit Science is to improve the understanding and interest in science education for both students and teachers for grades K-12. Nonprofit science is a charitable organization seeking to bring hand-on science activities, experiments, experimental supplies, scientific instruments, and qualified volunteers to schools and students in America.

Nonprofit Science Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purpose, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations qualifying as an exempt organization from Federal income tax under section 501 c(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. No on any other substantial part of the purpose of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and Nonprofit Science Inc. shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, Nonprofit Science Inc. shall not carry purpose not permitted to be carried on by (a) an organization exempt from Federal income tax under 501 c(3) on the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section for any future Federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170c(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of future Federal tax code.

SECTION III: RESPONSIBILITIES AND BYLAWS

The officers of Nonprofit Science Inc. adopted under board member resolution vote on October 15, 2010 are as follows:

Executive Director, President - Christee Bailey

Vice President - Amy Wilkes

Learning Specialist - Allison Turknet

Financial Accountant - Soren Brockdorf

Board members will review staffing needs and board membership annually and as needed. New officers will be elected by board member vote.

The president may establish special committees to undertake designated responsibilities on an as-needed basis.

The president will approve the budget and provide all financial reports.

The office of vice president and learning specialist will support the president in organizing activities and performing program tasks.

The majority of Nonprofit Science Inc. Board of Directors will be non-salaried and can not vote on their own compensation. Compensation will be determined primarily by grant funding for study work performed. Salaries will only be distributed by a vote of the Board of Directors.

SECTION IV: BOARD RESOLUTION:

The president will provide opportunities for the board members and significant contract and volunteer personnel to review program plans and make improvements to educational plans and activities. Program decision will be made and recorded by the president.

SECTION V: DISSOLUTION AGREEMENT:

Upon future dissolution of Nonprofit Science Inc. all financial holdings will be transferred to another educational and charitable organization. All assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501c (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of by the Court of Pleas of Duval county, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

SECTION VI: NONPROFIT SCIENCE INC. ACTIVITIES:

The charitable activities of Nonprofit Science Inc will be to measure science interest, deliver science activities and lessons by grade level to students in grades K-12 at several culturally diverse sites initiating in Jacksonville, Florida. The president, contract workers, and volunteers of Nonprofit Science will deliver programs and activities at local schools and wherever there is interest nationally. The Nonprofit Science president, Christee Bailey, is a material science engineer who has been designing and conducting science activities on a volunteer basis for over five years at her childrens' schools. Amy Wilkes graduated with degrees in business and finance and has also been designing and conducting science activities on a volunteer basis for over five years at her childrens' schools. Allison Turknet is a certified elementary school teacher with an active focus in hands-on learning. Soren Brockdorf is an MBA/CPA and is familiar with Nonprofit Science Inc. activities and programs. Prior funding for Nonprofit Science Inc. has been personal contributions from Christee Bailey, Amy Wilkes, and affiliated parent/student contributions.

Nonprofit Science Inc. will also develop and maintain an educator/student website devoted to hands-on science activities. A grade level activity and subject guide will be included to help teachers make science activity choices. Associated instruments, books, and activity supplies will be listed and sourced for easy procurement.

Nonprofit Science Inc. may also collect information and make reports concerning scientific career interest and program success in the schools it works with.

Nonprofit Science Inc seeks to obtain a grant to perform educational science programs in K-12 schools and coordinate qualified volunteers from the community.
