ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MILITARY MOMS PRAYER GROUP, INC.

The undersigned incorporator hereby forms a not-for-profit corporation under Chapter 617 of the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be as follows:

MILITARY MOMS PRAYER GROUP, INC.

The principal place of business of this Corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") shall be 940 Lantern Lane, Vero Beach, Florida 32963, and the mailing address shall be the same.

ARTICLE II. POWERS

This Corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof, and the specific purposes for which it is formed are to provide support to American troops deployed around the globe by promoting prayer and outreach efforts, such as annual holiday gift drives for the troops and other services. The Corporation shall have the following express powers and shall be permitted and authorized to:

- (a) fix, levy, and collect dues to sustain the Corporation;
- (b) acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate, or dispose of real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the Corporation;
- (c) borrow money, and with the assent of two-thirds (2/3rds) of the voting interests of the members, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred;
- (d) have and exercise any and all powers, rights, and privileges which a corporation organized under the Florida Not-for-Profit Corporation Act (Chapter 617, Florida Statutes) by law may now or hereafter have or exercise pursuant to said Chapter;

(e) make application for and take all steps necessary to obtain special tax treatment under U.S. Treasury regulations, including but not limited to Section 501(c)3, treatment.

ARTICLE III. MEMBERSHIP

Every person or entity, who has paid the required dues to the Corporation, as established periodically by the Corporation, if any, or any person or entity named by a majority of the members of the Board of Directors to membership, shall be and be deemed a member of the Corporation. A list of members shall at all times be maintained by the Corporation. The Corporation may elect to collect dues from members who are or are to be elected to the Board of Directors or from members generally but has no obligation to do so. Initially, the Corporation does not envision the admission of members beyond the initial members of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IV. ADDRESS

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation shall be 940 Lantern Lane, Vero Beach, Florida 32963, and the name of the initial registered agent of the Corporation at that address is **PAM PROCTOR**.

ARTICLE V. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall be deemed to exist and its operation commenced upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida, Tallahassee, Florida. This Corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE VI. VOTING RIGHTS

All Members whose dues payments, if any, to the Corporation are current and in good standing are entitled to vote on all matters pertaining to the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII. DISSOLUTION

The Corporation may be dissolved with the assent given in writing and executed by not less than eighty (80.0%) percent of the voting interests of the members. In the event of dissolution, all of the Corporation's assets shall be granted, conveyed, and assigned to any not-for-profit corporation, association, trust or other like organization.

ARTICLE VIII. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

This Corporation shall have initially six (6) directors. The names and street addresses of the initial directors are as follows:

The manner in which the directors shall be elected shall be as specified and set forth in the By-Laws adopted by the Corporation. Specifically, the membership by majority vote of all of the members shall select the directors. Each director must formally affirm and acknowledge that Jesus Christ is her Lord and Savior.

ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENTS

Amendment of these Articles shall require the assent of fifty-five (55%) percent of the voting interests of the members. The right to amend the By-Laws shall be vested in the members as set forth therein.
