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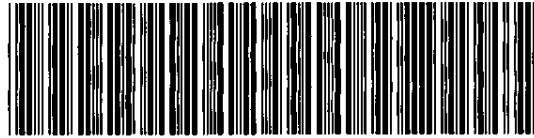

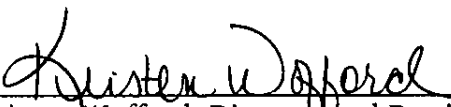

#### **ARTICLE VIII**

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

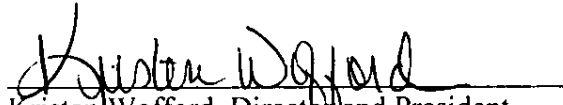
#### ARTICLE IX

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be disposed of according to the procedures outlined in Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. A private individual shall only be entitled to share in any distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation to the extent such distribution is permitted by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code.
