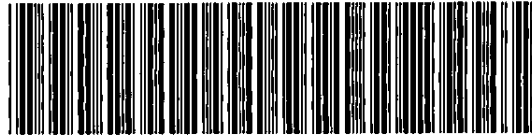

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
Covenant Presbyterian Church, Inc.**

**ARTICLE I. NAME**

The name of this corporation is Covenant Presbyterian Church, Inc.

**ARTICLE II. Principal Office**

The principal street address of Covenant Presbyterian Church, Inc. is 475 Commerce Lake Dr. St. Augustine, Florida and the mailing address is 20 Dune Street, St. Augustine, Florida 32080

**ARTICLE III. PURPOSE**

The corporation is organized exclusively for religious purposes which include charitable and educational purposes in the furtherance of the Christian Faith and further governed by the standards of the Westminster Confession of Faith and "The Book of Church Order" of the Orthodox Presbyterian Church. Furthermore the Corporation shall from time to time make distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in the furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article. The Corporation shall not participate in political campaigns on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office or participate in lobbying efforts to influence legislation. The Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 ( c ) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal code.

#### ARTICLE IV. DISSOLUTION OF THE CORPORATION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c ) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are operated exclusively for such purposes.

#### ARTICLE V. MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

Directors of the Corporation shall be elected at an annual election by the members of the Corporation for a term of one year. In the event of death, resignation or removal of a Director (s), the successor (s) shall be appointed by the existing Board of Directors and the said successor shall serve until the next annual meeting of the members of the Corporation.

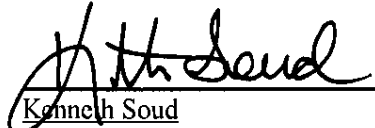

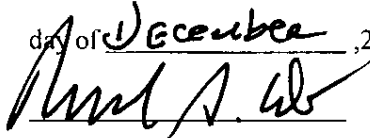
