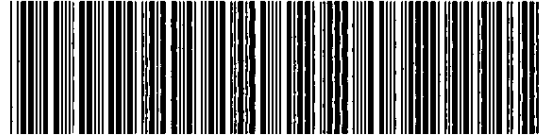

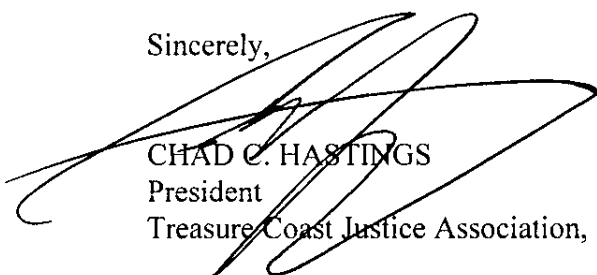

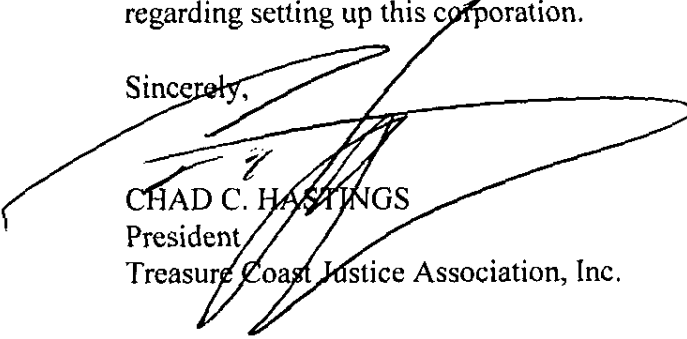

We, the undersigned, pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, certify that the following Articles of Incorporation of Florida Justice Association, Inc., were first approved by the Board of Directors and then were duly proposed by them to the general membership who, on August 4, 2009, passed by vote exceeding 2/3 of the members present, the following Resolution: BE IT RESOLVED, that the Charter of The Treasure Coast Justice Association, Inc. reads and provides as follows:

ARTICLE I NAME

Section 1. The name of this corporation shall be: TREASURE COAST JUSTICE ASSOCIATION, INC. a corporation not for profit herein referred to as "the Association".

ARTICLE II OBJECTIVES AND GOALS

Section 1. The objectives of this corporation are to:

- (a) Uphold and defend the principles of the Constitutions of the United States and the State of Florida.

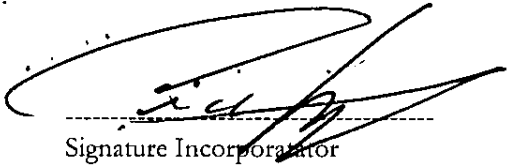
