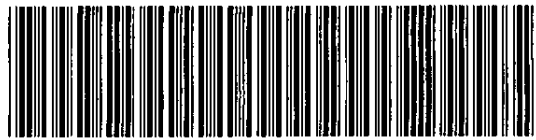

ARTICLE I NAME
