

- ARTICLE III- PURPOSE

 1. Feed the Need Garden, Inc. is an organization that focuses on teaching sustainable. STATE agriculture practices to low-income families. By teaching basic skills such as gardening, food preservation and raising livestock, we are enabling low-income families in our community to supply the food needed to sustain their family.
