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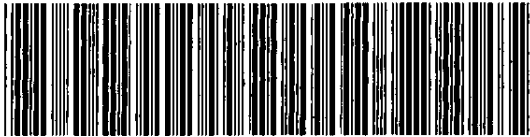

ARTICLE III- PURPOSE

1. The mission of Real Art, Inc. is to spread out all culture, music, art and literature to our new generation today. 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
3.
