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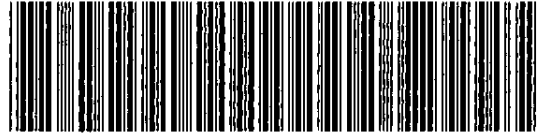

Articles of Incorporation (Original Copy)
In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

Article I. Name

The name of the corporation shall be: Marketplace Global Ministries, Inc.

Article II. Location

Address and location: 955 53rd Street E. Apt. #1024 Bradenton Fl. 34208

Article III. Purpose(s)

- (a.) To operate as a Non-Profit, Non-denominational religious and Christian organization by preaching and teaching the Word of God from the Holy Bible and doctrines of the Christian faith including but not limited to the administration of the sacraments and ordinances held by the Christian faith such as Baptism and Communion (The Lords Supper), the fellowship of Worship Services, edification of the believers, and evangelizing the unbeliever.
- (b.) Performing weddings, funerals, counseling, and baby dedications.
- (c.) Community outreach and charitable works such as food distribution, clothing, and community fairs to serve the community.
- (d.) Receiving, holding, and disbursing gifts, and obtaining funds from private, state, government, and public resources allowable within the non-profit laws codes, and statutes according to the 501 (c) 3 section of the Internal Revenue code and tax laws.
- (e.) Licensing and ordination of qualified ministers both men and women.
- (f.) Building and planting of new ministries.
- (g.) Acquiring, owning, and maintaining real estate, buildings, and other properties that may be donated or purchased for the ministry.

Article VI. Exemption Requirements

At all times the following shall operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the corporation:

1. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in the purpose clause hereof.
2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

3. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future tax code, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code.

Article V. Manner of Election.

The manner in which officers or directors are elected or appointed.

This will be a non-voting organization. All positions under the senior pastor and/or co-pastor will be done by appointment only. Only the senior pastor or co-pastor in the senior pastor's absence will have the power and authority to appoint and remove any or all members of the board of elders or officers. In the absence of or in the event the senior pastor should expire by death, the co-pastor will be the first to take responsibility, and if the co-pastor is not available, an elder will already have been designated to take over and assume leadership and responsibility of the ministry and that individual will be appointed by the senior pastor and will operate as the senior pastor with all power and authority to act in the best interest of the corporation or ministry.


