(A not for profit corporation)

MINTER SERVICES OF In compliance with the requirements of F.S. Chapters 607 and 617, the undersig hereby acts as an incorporator in adopting and filing the following articles of incorporation for the purpose of organizing a not for profit corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is: PANAMA CITY ROTARY FOUNDATION, INC., a not for profit corporation.

ARTICLE II

The physical address of the initial principal office of this corporation is 304 Magnolia Avenue, Panama City, Florida 32401, whose mailing address is P. O. Box 2303, Panama City, Florida 32402.

ARTICLE III

The corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE IV

The initial street address of the Corporation's registered office is: 304 Magnolia Avenue, Panama City, Florida 32401. The initial registered agent for the Corporation at that address is: Dion J. Moniz, Esq.

ARTICLE V

Charitable Purposes

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed, and the business and objects to be carried on and promoted by it, are as follows:

- (a) Exclusive Purpose. This Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, health and/or educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding section of any future United States internal revenue law.
- (b) Net Earnings. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers, or private persons,

except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services actually rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its exempt purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from Federal income taxation under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding section of any future United State internal revenue law, or (2) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 1 70(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding section of any future United States internal revenue law.

(c) <u>Dissolution</u>. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, all of the remaining assets of the Corporation shall be distributed only to one or more organizations created and operated for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Article II(a) hereof, other than for religious purposes all of the foregoing within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding section of any future United States internal revenue law, or shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
