ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION OF A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION ARTICLE I – CORPORATE NAME

Gulf Coast Veterans Advocacy Council, Inc.



ARTICLE II - CORPORATE NATURE

This is a nonprofit corporation, organized solely for general charitable purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporations Not for Florida Law set in Part I of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statues.

ARTICLE III - GENERAL AND SPECIFIC PURPOSE

The Corporation (1) supports the overall mission of the Gulf Coast Veterans Health Care System; (2) identifies barriers in accessing health care services to include, but not limited to, mental health services at veterans' health clinics; (3) helps to develop a method of measuring veteran's satisfaction, and advocating for needed changes and setting priorities for recommended changes; (4) expresses concerns or dissatisfaction with the quality of existing health care; (5) makes recommendations to mental health Executive Leadership and the Gulf Coast Veterans' Health Care System, which reflect the needs of the veterans and their families.

The General purpose for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for such charitable and educational purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal laws, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify for tax-exempt organizations under that Code.

The specific purpose for which this cooperation is formed are to corporate for advancement charity and education, and for other charitable purpose, by the distributions of its funds for such purpose.

This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of it activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate of intervene (by public or distribution of an statement or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV - COMENCEMENT AND DURATION

The corporation is to commence it corporate existence on the date of subscription and acknowledgement of these articles of incorporation and shall exist perpetually thereafter until dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE V - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

All corporate powers shall be exercises by and under the authority of, and business and affairs of the corporation shall be managed under the direction of board of directors.

The corporation shall have seven (7) directors initially. The number of directors may thereafter be increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with the bylaws of the corporation.


