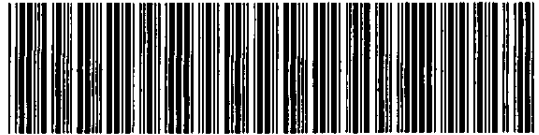

Purposes

The purposes for which this nonprofit corporation is organized are as follows:
