

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

CLIFTWOOD HOME OWNERS ASSOCIATION IN 18 P 2: 37 (A FLORIDA NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION)

SECRETARY OF STATE

We the undersigned, being not less than two-thirds (2/3) of all mobile Home owners of Cliftwood Mobile Home Park for the purpose of forming a not for profit Corporation under Florida Statutes Chapter 617, do hereby make and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation is "Cliftwood Home Owners Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II NOT FOR PROFIT

The corporation is a not for profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida. The corporation is not formed for pecuniary profit. No part of any income or assets of the corporation is distributable to or for the benefit of its members, directors or officers except to the extent permissible under the law.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES

The corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively as a non-stock organization for the following purposes:

- a) To establish an association of the owners of mobile homes located at 7101 West Anthony Road, Ocala, Florida 34479 and located in Marion County, Florida;
- b) In order to exercise the rights provided in Florida Statutes 723.071 including, but not limited to, exercising it's right to negotiate for, acquire and operate the mobile park of Cliftwood Mobile Home Park on behalf of the mobile home owners.
- c) In order to exercise it's right to convert the mobile home park into a condominium form of ownership, or other type of ownership pursuant to Florida law;
- d) To exercise and engage in any other powers or business of mobile home park associations as permitted under Florida law;
- e) To engage in any lawful activities which are in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation as described herein; and
- f) To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida up not for profit corporations, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to acquire by bequest, devise, gift, purchase, lease or otherwise any

property of any sort or nature without limitation as to its amount or value and to hold, reinvest, manage, use, apply, employ, sell, expend, disburse, lease, mortgage, convey, option, donate or otherwise dispose of such property and the income, principal and proceeds of such property, for any of the purposes set forth herein, and to do such other things as are incidental to the purposes of the corporation or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish them.

ARTICLE IV DURATION AND DATE OF COMMENCEMENT

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual, and the Corporation shall commence at the time and date of filing these Articles with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE V LIMITATION

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees or officers, but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article Ill (Purposes) hereof.

ARTICLE VI MEMBERS

The corporation shall have members who shall have all rights and privileges of voting members of the corporation. The qualification for members and the manner of their admission shall be as stated in the bylaws. The names of the initial members are as listed in Exhibit "A"

ARTICLE VII INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial Principal and Registered Office of the Corporation is 7101 West Anthony Road, Lot # 23 Ocala, Florida and the name of its initial Registered Agent is James E. Robins

Having been named as registered agent to accept service of process for the above stated corporation
at the place designated in this certificate, I am familiar with and accept the appointment as registered
agent and agree to act in this capacity.

ARTICLE VIII INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The management of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors. The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is five (5). The number of Directors may be increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with the bylaws, but shall never be less than three (3). The members of the corporation shall elect the directors as provided in the bylaws. The initial Directors are:

The Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment to them, and all rights and privileges conferred upon the members, directors and officers are subject to this reservation. The Articles of Incorporation may be amended in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Florida, as amended from time to time, unless more specific provisions for amendments are adopted by the Corporation pursuant to law.

ARTICLE XIII IDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify each Officer and Director, including the former Officers and Directors, to the fullest extent permitted by the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE XIV NONSTOCK BASIS

This Corporation is organized on a nonstock basis. This Corporation shall not issue shares of stock.
