

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
(Not for Profit)

**Article I – Name**

The name of the Corporation shall be Outlet Thru Noise, Inc.

**Article II – Principal Office**

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation is 4934 NW 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Suite 103, Gainesville, Florida 32606.

**Article III - Purpose**

The specific purpose for which this Corporation is organized is to contribute to the health and welfare of children and adolescents who are the victims of domestic violence and abuse by providing such persons with an opportunity to empower and express themselves through discussion forums and other modes of self expression; and, further, to increase public awareness about domestic violence against children and adolescents.

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

#### Article IV – Manner of Election

The manner in which the directors are to be elected or appointed shall be as stated in the bylaws of the Corporation.


