ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

THE HANK YOUNG MEMORIAL FOUNDATION, INC. A Florida Not For Profit Corporation

<u>ARTICLE I</u>

The name of the Corporation shall be "The Hank Young Memorial Foundation, Inc." Description of the Corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

<u>ARTICLE II</u>

The purpose of the Corporation is to honor Christ, further His Kingdom, and continue the legacy of Henry E. (Hank) Young.

ARTICLE III

The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be conducted, managed and controlled by its Board of Directors. The directors shall be elected and removed as provided in the Corporation's Bylaws. ARTICLE VI

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and religious purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VIII

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
