THE AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

MIAMI CHINESE LANGUAGE SCHOOL, INC.

The undersigned, being the duly acting and appointed President and Secretary of the Miami Chinese Language School, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit private school corporation ("Corporation") formed under and pursuant to Chapters 617 and 623 of the laws of the State of Florida, do hereby certify as follows:

That the Articles of Incorporation of this Corporation were duly adopted and approved by the Circuit Court of the State of Florida in and for Miami-Dade County on April 3, 1981;

That the Articles of Incorporation were amended by an Amendment to Articles of Incorporation dated June 21, 1982 and approved by the Circuit Court of the State of Florida in and for Miami-Dade County on June 29, 1982; and

That on February 5, 2009 the active members of the Corporation approved a Resolution to further amend and to restate the Articles of Incorporation as follows:

Article I Name

The name of this Corporation is Miami Chinese Language School, Inc., a private school.

Article II Location

This corporation will operate a school in the City of Coral Gables, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and such other communities in the State of Florida or County of Miami-Dade, as needs require.

Article III Purpose

The purposes for which this Corporation is organized are as follows:

a) To foster a Chinese language program to the members and dependents of members, persons of Chinese ancestry, who are

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living in the United States and who wish to learn the Chinese language;

- b) To promote a better understanding of the Chinese culture;
- c) To acquaint its members with their Chinese heritage through social and cultural activities;
- d) To implement, operate and carry on a Chinese language laboratory;
- e) Without in any way limiting any of the purposes of the Corporation it is expressly declared and provided that the Corporation to carry on its purposes or for the purpose of accomplishing any of the objectives hereinabove mentioned shall have all the powers to do any and all acts and things conferred by Chapter 617 of the Laws of the State of Florida upon not-for-profit corporations formed under the laws of said State and which now or hereafter may be authorized by law;
- f) To do any act or thing incidental to or connected with the foregoing purposes and powers or in the advancement thereof but not for the pecuniary profit or financial gain of its directors, officers, or members except as permitted under the not-for-profit corporate law.

Article IV Term

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

Article V Members

The members of this Corporation shall be those persons who have a bona fide interest in Chinese language or Chinese culture and who are residents of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Article VI Amendments

The Board of Directors reserves the rights to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles in a manner now or hereafter prescribed by law. Any and all such amendments shall be adopted by a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors pursuant to procedures set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation.



Article VII Bylaws

The Board of Directors by two-thirds vote may adopt, alter or rescind the Bylaws of this Corporation.

Article VIII Limitations

The following limitations shall in all events apply to the organization, operation and dissolution of the Corporation:

- 1. Any provision herein to the contrary notwithstanding, this Corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and such provision shall in all events limit the purpose for which this Corporation is formed. This Corporation shall have and exercise only those powers that are in furtherance of its exempt purposes.
- 2. Any provision herein to the contrary notwithstanding, no part of the assets, income, or net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the Corporation shall not participate in nor intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or (b) by an organization, contribution's to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the



corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

- 3. Any provision herein to the contrary notwithstanding, upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation, shall dispose of, or make provision for the disposal of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purpose of the Corporation in such manner or to such organization or organizations organized and operating exclusively for charitable, or educational, purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), as the Board of Directors in their sole discretion shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
- 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this Corporation, during the period it is a private foundation as defined in section 509 (a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 including corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, shall not:
 - a. Engage in any act of "self-dealing" as defined in Section 4941 (d) which would give rise to any liability for the tax imposed by Section 4941 (a);
 - b. Retain any "excess business holdings" as defined in Section 4943 (c) which would give rise to any liability for the tax imposed by Section 4943 (a);
 - c. Make any investment which would jeopardize the carrying out of any of its exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 4944 so as to give rise to any liability for the tax imposed by Section 4944 (a); and
 - d. Make any "taxable expenditures" as defined in Section 4945 (d) which would give rise to any liability for the tax imposed by Section 4945 (a).

In addition, this Corporation, during the period it is a "private foundation" as defined in section 509(a) shall distribute for the purposes specified above for each taxable

year amounts at least sufficient to avoid liability for the tax imposed by Section 4942 (a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 including corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.


