AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

FRIENDS OF THE MINNEOLA SCHOOLHOUSE LIBRARY, INCA A Corporation Not for Profit

The Board of Directors adopted these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporatio July 25, 2011. No member vote was required.

ARTICLE I - NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of the corporation is FRIENDS OF THE MINNEOLA SCHOOLHOUSE LIBRARY, INCORPORATED. The street address of the registered office of this corporation is 100 S. Main Avenue, Minneola, FL 34715. The mailing address of this corporation is PO Box 678, Minneola, FL 34755.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE AND POWERS

The general nature and purpose of the FRIENDS OF THE MINNEOLA SCHOOLHOUSE LIBRARY, INCORPORATED shall be to promote and otherwise encourage the support of its members and of the general public at large in advancing the growth and quality of the Minneola Schoolhouse Library. FRIENDS OF THE MINNEOLA SCHOOLHOUSE LIBRARY, INCORPORATED may charge dues, set qualifications for membership and admit or eject members. Any such assets not dispose of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
