Articles of Incorporation of Global Baptist College, Inc.



The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

Article 1

The name of the corporation is GLOBAL BAPTIST COLLEGE, INC.

Article 2

The principle place of business of the corporation is 5634 NORMANDY BOULEVARD, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32205 and the mailing address of the corporation is P. O. BOX 6458, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32236-6458.

Article 3

The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), including, but not limited to, for such purposes, the establishing and maintaining of a Bible-centered educational institution of higher learning dedicated to training men and women for the ministry of the gospel and any other lawful purpose not specifically prohibited to corporations under the laws of the state of Florida that is in furtherance of tax-exempt purposes.

Article 4

The affairs of the corporation shall be conducted by the board of directors of the corporation. The method of election of directors shall be stated in the Bylaws of the corporation. The corporation shall have a minimum of three (3) directors.

Article 5

The corporation shall not have members.

Article 6

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the tax-exempt purposes of the corporation set forth in Article 3.

Article 7

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation to WEST JACKSONVILLE BAPTIST CHURCH, INC., if said corporation shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. If WEST JACKSONVILLE BAPTIST CHURCH, INC. does not qualify as an exempt organization at the time of dissolution, the assets shall be distributed to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an organization exempt from Federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article 8

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Article 9

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 5634 NORMANDY BOULEVARD, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32205, and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at the initial registered office is RODNEY KELLEY.

Article 10

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, except that the corporation shall not carry on any activities not

permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article 11

The corporation shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, or national or ethnic origin. The corporation shall admit students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students and shall be racially nondiscriminatory in the administration of all of its policies and programs.

Article 12

The name of the incorporator is RODNEY KELLEY and the address of the incorporator is 5634 NORMANDY BOULEVARD, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32205.

Article 13

The period of the duration of the corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law.
