Sarasota Youth Sports Training and Education Mentorship

In compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (Not for Profit), the undersigned, all of whom 12: 13 are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I- NAME: The name of the Corporation shall be Sarasota Youth Sports Training and Educational Mentorship, Inc..

ARTICLE II- PRINCIPAL OFFICE: The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is 301 South School Avenue, Sarasota, Florida, 34237.

ARTICLE III- PURPOSE: The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, to provide a facility and setting where student athletes and the youth in the community will be taught, challenged, supported and inspired to train for optimal performance in sports and physical fitness with an emphasis on mental awareness education; including such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VIII - DISSOLUTION: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court in and for Sarasota County, Florida, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
