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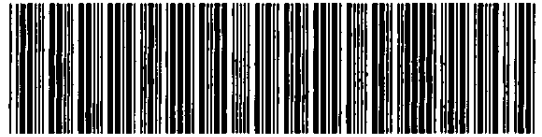

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

**ARTICLE I NAME**

The name of the corporation shall be:  
Nova Middle School Association, Inc.

**ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE**

The principal street address and mailing address, if different is:  
455 SW 5 Ave., Fort Lauderdale FL 33315

**ARTICLE III PURPOSE**

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

Sec. 1: to enhance the relationship between school and home by providing parents and educators cooperative opportunities to provide for the physical emotional social, and moral education of children attending Nova Middle School and to improve the school's facilities and physical and social environment whenever possible.  
Sec. 2: to render voluntary assistance to develop and implement the total program of student instruction and education, but not direct the administration of Nova Middle School.  
Sec. 3: to be non-commercial, non-sectarian, non-partisan and non-racial. The name of the association and its officers shall not be used in an official capacity in connection with any commercial concern or partisan interest, or for any purpose other than regular work of the association.  
Sec. 4: to cooperate with other organizations and agencies active in child welfare, such as conference groups or coordinating councils, provided that they make no commitments binding upon this association.  
Sec. 5: to deliver any assets upon dissolution to the Broward Education Foundation, Inc., a non-profit organization established to benefit the Broward County Public Schools.

**ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION**

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed:

Sec. 1: No later than May 1 of each year following the year of incorporation, the executive board shall appoint a nominating committee of three persons, including one board member selected by the president and two non-board members. The nominating committee shall propose a slate of at least one nominee for each office, and post same on the NMESA bulletin board or front office door at the school no later than five (5) school days before the May meeting. Nominations may also be made for chair of any committee or event authorized by the executive board. The consent of each nominee must be obtained. Additional nominations may be made from the floor at the May meeting, provided the consent of the nominee has been obtained.  
Sec. 2: Officers shall be elected for the succeeding association year at the May meeting of each year. No officer shall be eligible for the same office for more than two consecutive terms. The executive board shall fill vacant positions occurring at any other time, with the approval of at least four (4) members being required to declare or fill a vacancy. The association year shall run from June 1 to May 31.  
Sec. 3: Initial officers shall adopt bylaws not inconsistent with these articles of incorporation, to include provision for amendment not inconsistent with these articles of incorporation.
