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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR CHRIST APOSTOLIC CHURCH ST.PETERSBURG, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a nonprofit organization under the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, hereby accepts all the rights, privileges, benefits and obligations conferred and imposed by said law on corporations pursuant to the provisions thereof, and does hereby make, subscribe, certify, acknowledge and file these Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTCLE 1 - NAME

The name of the organization shall be: CHRIST APOSTOLIC CHURCH ST. PETERSBURG, INC.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRES

The Principal place of business and mailing address of the nonprofit corporation shall be: 1400 34th Street North, ST. Petersburg, Florida 33713

ARTICLE III - DURATION

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSE

The purposes for which the organization is organized are exclusively religious and charitable within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

No part of the net earning of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislature, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding section of any future tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in section 501 (b)(3) and170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.

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ARTICLE V - LIMITATION

The organization is not formed for pecuniary profit. No part of the income or assets of the organization is distributable to or for the benefit of its Members, Trustees or Officers, except to the extent permissible under law. The organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV (Purpose) hereof.

ARTICLE VI ~ YOTING MEMBERS

The organization shall have voting members who shall be elected (and may be removed) by the voting members and shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the Corporation. The Bylaws may provide for Nonvoting members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such manner and who shall have rights and privileges as are set forth in the Bylaws, but who shall not have the right to vote. ARTICLE VII - INITIAL BOARD OF TRUSTEES

ARTICLES XII - AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES

The organization reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment to them, and all rights and privileges conferred upon the Members, Trustees and Officers are subject to this reservation. The Articles of Incorporation may be amended in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Florida, as amended from time to time, unless more specific provisions for amendments are adopted by the Corporation pursuant to law.

ARTICLE XIII - INDEMNIFICATION

The organization shall indemnify each Officer and Trustee, including former Officers and Trustees, to the full extent permitted by the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE XIV - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or a state or local government, for a public purpose, Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
