Articles of Incorporation of

The Women's Foundation for the Promotion of Health and Fitness, Inc.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This Corporation shall be a nonprofit corporation. The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized to serve three main purposes:1) To create a forum for sharing of information regarding health and fitness and sharing of best practices among women that are involved or can have an impact in this area 2) raising the awareness of how to incorporate healthy living into a busy lifestyle 3) How parents (particularly mother's and grandmother's make a difference in creating healthier lifestyles for children.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
