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

Articles of Incorporation

In Compliance with Florida Statutes Chapter 617, the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit corporation organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code) including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- B. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

The Foundation will serve underserved and special populations, with special emphasis given to single parents providing custodial/parental care of minor child(ren) and single pregnant mothers,

- (i) to promote professional, academic or artistic achievement;
- (ii) to grant financial assistance and scholarships to students who wish to further their education or train in a vocation, or who are pursuing undergraduate or graduate education;
- (iii) to mentor prospective students as they apply for admission and financial aid and begin taking educational courses;
- (iv) to assist with living expenses, as prescribed in the corporation Bylaws, to those who demonstrate insufficient assets or income to do so while pursuing educational endeavors.

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IV

The Directors shall be elected at each annual meeting of the Board of Directors as prescribed in the corporation Bylaws.

- A. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.
- B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

C. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

VIII

- A. The corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at such a time and in such a manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by 26 U.S.C.A. § 4942, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- B. The corporation will not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in 26 U.S.C.A. § 4941(d), or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- C. The corporation will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in 26 U.S.C.A. § 4943(c), or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- D. The corporation will not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under 26 U.S.C.A. § 4944, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- E. The corporation will not make any taxable expenditures as defined in 26 U.S.C.A. § 4945(d), or the corresponding section of any future federal revenue code.

IX

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code).
