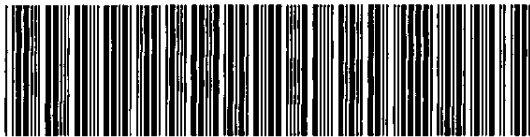

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
(Not for Profit)
OF
INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY FOR AUTISM, INC.**

Article I – Name

The name of the Corporation shall be International Society for Autism, Inc.

Article II – Principal Office

The principal address of the Corporation is 580 Jefferson Drive, Apt. 102, Deerfield Beach, Florida 33442, and the mailing address of the Corporation is 7040 W. Palmetto Park Road, Suite 4-832, Boca Raton, Florida 33433-3461.

Article III - Purpose

The specific purposes for which this Corporation is organized are as follows: (1) The Corporation will raise and solicit donations for scholarships. These scholarships will be used to provide clients, who are in financial need, monies to support tuitions for clinical programs specifically designed for young adults with autism spectrum disorder and other pervasive developmental disorders. (2) The Corporation will engage in scientific research on clinical disorders and treatments for young adults with autism spectrum disorders and other pervasive developmental disorders. Money from donations will be used to help fund research in this area. (3) The Corporation will provide clinical advisory services to other organizations, assisting them in becoming certified as a provider of clinical intervention services for young adults with autism spectrum disorders and other pervasive developmental disorders.

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article IV – Manner of Election

The manner in which the directors are to be elected or appointed shall be as stated in the bylaws of the Corporation.






