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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (not for profit)

ARTICLE 1: NAME & ADDRESS

The name of the corporation is: Community Youth Recreational Center, Inc.

ARTICLE 2: DURATION

The corporation shall exist perpetually. In accordance with section 607.0203, the date when existence shall commence is the date of subscription and acknowledgment of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE 3: PURPOSE

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and Scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify a exempt organizations under 501(c)(3) of the internal revenue code, or the corresponding section of any future Internal Revenue Code. In furtherance of this Corporations charitable nature, said corporation shall adhere to its mission statement which includes but is not limited to the development of mind, body and spirit of today's young people.

ARTICLE 4:

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized to and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for service rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in Article 3, hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in(including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or correspondence section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or Correspondence section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE 5: Dissolution of Corporation

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or the state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose or such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE 6: Manner of Election

This not for profit corporation shall have three directors initially. The number of directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time by the by-laws, but shall never be less than three.

ARTICLE 11: Principal Initial Office



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
