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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION 1338 PENNSYLVANIA CONDOMINIUM

ASSOCIATION, INC. (A FLORIDA CORPORATION

NOT-FOR-PROFIT)

In order to form a corporation not-for-profit under and in accordance with Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, we, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves into a corporation not-for-profit for the purposes and with the powers hereinafter set forth and to that end, we do, by these Articles of Incorporation, certify as follows:

EXPLANATION OF TERMINOLOGY

The terms contained in these Articles which are contained in the Declaration of Condominium ("Declaration") creating 1336 PENNSYLVANIA, A CONDOMINIUM, shall have the meaning of such terms set forth in the Declaration.

ARTICLE !

NAME

The name of this Association short 1336 PENNSYLVANIA CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC., whose Tripresent address to 1336 PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE, MIAMI BEACH, FL 33139

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE OF ASSOCIATION

The purpose for which this Association is organized is to maintain, operate and monage the Condominium and to operate, lease, trade, sell and otherwise deal with the personal and real property thereof.

ARTICLE III

POWERS

The Association shall have the following powers which shall be governed by the following provisions:

- A. The Association shall have all of the common law and statutory powers of a corporation not-for-profit and all powers set forth in the Florida Statutes Chapter 718, Florida Statutes Chapter 607, and Florida Statutes Chapter 817 which are not in conflict with or limit the terms of the Declaration, these Articles and the By-Laws of the Act.
- 8. The Association that have all of the powers of an owners association under the Act and shall have all of the powers reasonably necessary to implement the purposes of the Association, including, but not limited to, the following:
- To make, establish and enforce responsible Rules and Regulations governing the Condominium and the use of Units;
- To make, levy, collect and enforce Special Assessments and Annual Assessments against Owners and to provide funds to pey for the expenses of the Association and the maintenance, operation and management of the Condominium in the manner provided in the Doctaration, these Articles, the Sy-Laws and the Condominium Act and to use and expond the proceeds of such Assessments in the exercise of the powers and duties of the Association;

 3. To resintaln, repair, replace and operate the Condominant in accordance with the Danieration,
- these Articles, the By-Laws and the Act;
- To reconstruct improvements of the Condominium in the event of casualty or other loss in accordance with the Declaration:
- 5, To enforce by legal moons the provisions of the Deckmitton, these Articles, the By-Laws and the Act; and,
- To employ personnot, retain inclapandent contractors and professional personnel and order into service contracts to provide for the maintenance, operation and management of the Condominium and to enter into each other agreements that are consistent with the purpose of the Association.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERS

The qualification of Members, the manner of their admission to membership in the Association, the member of the termination of such membership and voting by Members shall be as follows:

- Until such limb as the reportation of the Doctaration, the Members of this Association shall be comprised solely of the Subscribers ("Subscriber Members") to these Articles; and in line event of the resignation or termination of any Subscriber Member, the remaining Subscriber Members may nominate and designate a successor Subscriber Member. Each of the Subscriber Members shall be children to cast one (1) rate on all matters requiring a vote of the Members.
- B. Upon the recordation of the Declaration, the Subscriber Members' rights and interests shall be automatically terminated and the Owners, which in the first instance means Developer as the owner of the Units. aball be

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entitled to exercise all of the rights and privileges of Members.

- C. Mambership in the Association shall be established by the acquisition of ownership of a Condominium Unit in the property as evidenced by the recording of an instrument of conveyance amongst the Public Records of Mismi Now Members shall deliver a trust copy of the recorded deed or other instrument of acquiation of ritle to the Association.
- No Member may sasign, hypothecate or transfer in any manner his membership in the Association or his share in the funds and reside of the Association except as an appurtangmento his Condominium Unit.
- E. With respect to voting, the Members as a whole shall vote. Each Condominium Unit with respect to all matters upon which Owners (other than the Developer) are permitted or required to vote as set forth in the Declaration, these Articles or By-Laws shall be entitled to one vote for each Unit owned (unitoss attend pursuant to Article V of the Declaration) which vote shall be exercised and cast in accordance with the Declaration, these Articles and the By-Laws.

ARTICLE V

TERM

The term for which this Association is to exist shall be perpetual.

ARTICI-E VI

OFFICERS

- A. The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a President, one (1) or several Vice Presidents, a Secretary and a Treasurer and, if disclad by the Board, an Assistant Secretary and an Assistant Treasurer, which officers shall be subject to the directions of the Board.
- 5. The Board shall elect the President, the Vice Prosident, the Secretary, the Treasurer and as many other Vice Presidents, Assistant Secretaries and Assistant Treasurers as the Board shall from time to time determine appropriate. Such officers shall be elected annually by the Board at the first meeting of the Board, provided, however, such officers may be removed by such Board and other persons may be obsted by the Board as such officers in the manner provided in the By-Laws. The President shall be a Director of the Association, but no other officer need be a Director. The same person may hold two (2) offices, the duttes of which are not incompatible.

ARTICLE VIII

ARTICLE IX BOARD OF

Developer reserves the right to designate successor Directors to serve on the First Board for so long as the First Board is to serve, as hereinsfier provided.

- C. The First Board shall serve until the "Initial Election Meeting," as hereinafter described, which shall be held abdy (60) days after the sanding of notice by Daveloper to the Association that Daveloper voluntarily valvos its right to continue to designate the members of the First Board, whereupon the First Board shall resign and be succeeded by the "Initial Elected Board" (as hereinafter defined). Notwithstanding the toragoing, however, when unit owners other than the Developer own more than 15% of the units in the condominium, they shall be outilied to elect one-third (1/3) of the Board.
- D. Within soventy-five (75) days after the Unit Owners, other than the Developer, ere entitled to clock a member of the Board of Administration (Cirectors) of the Association, the Association, shall call, and give not less than aixty (60) days notice of an election for the members of the Board of Administration. The election shall proceed as provided in Florida Statutes Chapter 718, 112(2)(5). The notice may be given by any Unit Owner if the Association folis to do so. Upon election of the first Unit Owner, other than Developer, to the Board of Administration, the Developer shall forward to the Bureau of Condominiums the name and mailling address of the Unit Owner Board Member.

ARTICLE X

INCEMNIFICATION

Every Director and every officer of the Association (and the Directors and/or officers as a group) shall be indomnified by the Association against all expenses and liabifules, including counsel fees (at all triel and appellate levels) reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him or them in connection with any proceeding, litigation or settlement in which he may become involved by reason of his being or having been a Director or officer of the Association. The foregoing provisions for indemnification shall apply whether or not he is a Director or officer at the time such expenses are incurred. Notwithstanding the above, in instances where a Director or officer admits or is adjudged guilty of willful misfeasance or malfeasance in the performance of his duties, the indemnification provisions of these Articles shall not apply. Otherwise, the foregoing rights to indemnification to and not exclusive of any and all rights of indemnification to which a Director or officer may be entitled whether by statute or common law.

ARTICLE XI

BY-LAWS

The By-Laws of the Association shall be adopted by the First Board, and thereafter may be altered, amonded or rescinded in the manner provided for in the By-Laws and the Act. As its set forth in the By-Laws, the By-Laws may be amended by the affirmative vote of not less than a majority of the Members present at an Annual Members Meeting or a special meeting of the Members and the affirmative approval of a majority of the Board at a regular or special meeting of the Board. Subject to 718.110(4), and (8), Florida Statutes, notwithstanding enything contained herein to the contrary, while the Developer is entitled to appoint a majority of the Board of Directors, into By-Laws may be amonded by a Majority of the Board of Directors, provided that such Amendment shall not increase the proportion of common expenses nor increase the ownership of Common Elements bome by the Unit Owners or change a Unit Owner's voting rights without the consent of the affected by Unit Owners, Subject to 718.110(4), and (8), Florida Statutes, said Amendment need only be executed and ecknowledged by the Developer and the consent of the Unit Owners, the Association, the owner and holder of any lien encumbering a Unit in this Condominium, or any others, shall not be required.

ARTICLE XII

AMENDMENTS

- A. Prior to the recording of the Declaration amongst the Public Records of Mismi-Dade County, Florids, these Articles may be amended only by an instrument in writing signed by all of the Directors and filled in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florids. The instrument amending these Articles shall identify the particular Article or Articles being amended and give the exact tanguage of such amendment, and a cartifled copy of such amendment shall always be attached to any certified copy of these articles and shall be an exhibit to the Doctaration upon the recording of any such Declaration.
- B. After the recording of the Declaration amongst the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, these Articles may be smended in the following mannet;
- Notice of the subject matter of the proposed amondment shall be included in the notice of any
 meeting (whether of the Board or of the Members) at which such proposed amendment is to be considered; and
- 2. A resolution approving the proposed amendment may be first passed by either the Board or the Members. After such approval of a proposed amendment by one of said bodies, such proposed amendment must be submitted and approved by the other of said bodies. Approval by the Members must be by a vote of a mejority of the Members present at an enesting of the membership at which a quorum (as determined in accordance with the By-Laws) is present and approval by the Board must be by a mejority of the Directors present at any meeting of the Directors at which a quorum (as determined in accordance with the By-Laws) is present.
- C. A copy of each agreedment shall be certified by the Secretary of State and recorded amongst the Public Records of Minmi-Dade County, Florida.
- D. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Article XII, there shall be no amendment to those Articles which shall abridge, amond or alter the rights of Developer, including the right to designate and select the Directors as provided in Article IX hereof, or the provisions of this Article XII, without the prior written consent therefore by

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Developer.

Except as otherwise provided in Section 718.110(4) and 718.110(8), notwithstanding anything centained herein to the contrary, while the Developer is entitled to appoint a majority of the Board of Directors, these Articles may be amended by a majority of the Board of Directors evidenced by a certificate of the association, provided that such Amendment shall not increase the proportion of common expenses nor decrease the ownershy of Common Elements borne by the Unit Owners or change a Unit Owners and without the consent of the effected Unit Owners. Said Amendment need only be executed and adminished by the Association and the consent of the Unit Owners, the owner and holder of any lien annumbering a Unit in this Condominium, (or any others), shall not be required.
