The undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation laws of The State of Florida as set forth in Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, do hereby certify:

#### Article I - Name

The name of the Corporation shall be The South Howard Community Outreach Corporation.

## Article III - Purpose
