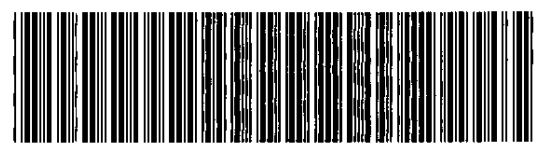

Articles of Amendment to Articles of Incorporation
Shining Light Garden Foundation, Inc.

Article I -- Section 1.02 -- Purpose

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This includes helping the poor, the homeless, and the elderly by growing fresh produce and giving the produce to them at no cost; supplying fresh produce to other nonprofit organizations who are equipped to cook hot meals for the hungry, the homeless, and the elderly; to increase community awareness by partnering with other nonprofit organizations that have the same mission and by conducting interviews with the local media, such as newspaper and radio.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislations, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article X - Dissolution:

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
