

- Article I:** The name and address of this principal corporation is Community Connexions, Inc. 315 SE 58th Ave., Ocala, FL 34471. The mailing address is P.O. Box 981, Silver Springs, FL 34489. The corporation is organized pursuant to the Florida Nonprofit Code.
- Article II:** This is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The corporation is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable and educational purposes to aid the poor and disadvantaged individuals and families towards a life of self-sufficiency. The programs will consist of, but shall not be limited to: Child Care, Job Training, Job Placement, Land Acquisition Housing, Employment, Literacy, Counseling, Temporary Shelter, Teenage Pregnancy, Substance Abuse Awareness and Prevention, Tutoring, AIDS Awareness and Education, Elderly Care and other programs to aid those in need.
- Article III:** The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual and have no stock.



Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
