ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION
OF
NORTHSIDE CHURCH OF CHRIST OF LAKE CITY, INC.

The undersigned, by these Articles, associate themselves for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be Northside Church of Christ, Inc.

ARTICLE II
PURPOSE

- A. The purpose for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, and educational within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code including: To provide and maintain a place of worship therefore: to provide and maintain a school for religious and educational instruction: to conduct religious and sacred concerts, radio and television broadcasts; to publish religious books and periodicals and to make religious recordings or conduct any other form of religious communication deemed appropriate to the foregoing purposes; to make contributions or gifts to or for the use, aid and assistance of people who are in need of financial assistance to maintain themselves or to provide for their medical and mental well-being; and to make contributions or gifts to or aid and assist missions and missionaries in the United States and abroad or to aid and assist institutions, organizations, agencies and activities which are organized and operated exclusively for religious charitable or educational purposes.
- B. In furtherance of its corporate purposes, the corporation shall have all of the general powers granted by the laws of the State of Florida, including the rights to take and hold by bequest, devise, gift, grant purchase, lease or otherwise, any property, rural, personal, tangible, or any interest therein, without limitation as to amount or value, and to sell, convey, or otherwise dispose of any such property, or mortgage of encumber same, and to invest, reinvest or deal with the principal or income thereof in such a manner as common in the judgment of the Board of Trustees, will best promote the purposes of this corporation.
- C. However, no part of the income of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director, officer or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes); and no member, trustee, or officer of the corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets upon the dissolution of the corporation.

- D. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE III

TERM

The term of the Corporation shall be perpetual and is organized pursuant to the Florida non-profit Corporation Code.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERS

The members of the corporation shall be those members who have made a confession of faith in Christ who have been baptized and who have been received into the membership of the Northside Church of Christ ("Church") by the act of baptism in accordance with the By-Laws and scriptural rules and procedures promulgated by the Board of Trustees and New Testament teaching for the admission of new members and for their resignation or removal. Such members who are deemed faithful are entitled to all the rights and privileges of the CHURCH, including the right to participate in the worship of the CHURCH, and to take part in the called meetings of the congregation and vote in the call meetings of the membership and to vote and hold office in the corporation and CHURCH as defined by the By-Laws and New Testament. A member shall serve until he resigns or is removed from membership. All members must be admitted to membership by acceptance of Jesus Christ. The power to remove a member from membership rests with the general membership of the corporation (CHURCH).

ARTICLE V

TRUSTEES

- A. MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD. The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the board consisting of the number of trustees determined by the By-Laws, but not less than three (3) trustees, and in the absence of such determination shall consist of three (3) trustees.
- B. ELECTION AND REMOVAL. Trustees of the corporation shall be elected at the annual meeting of the members in the manner determined by the By-Laws. Trustees may be removed and vacancies on the Board of Trustees shall be filled in the manner provided by the By-Laws.

- C. FIRST BOARD OF TRUSTEES. The names and addresses of members of the first Board of Trustees who shall hold office until their successors are elected and have qualified, or until removed are as follows:

The trustees named above shall serve until the First Election of trustees as defined in the By-Laws of the corporation and any vacancies in their number occurring before the First Election of Trustees shall be filled by the remaining Trustees.

ARTICLE VI
OFFICERS

ADMINISTRATION. The affairs of the corporation shall be administered by the officers designated in the By-Laws. After the First Election of Trustees, the officers shall be elected by the Board of Trustees at the first meeting following the annual meeting of a majority of the members of the corporation and shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Trustees. ARTICLE VIII

REGISTERED OFFICE

ARTICLE X

MISCELLANEOUS

- A. This corporation shall issue no shares of stock of any kind or nature whatsoever. Membership in the corporation shall be upon such terms and conditions as provided for in Article IV above and the By-Laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE XI

AMENDMENTS

The Board of Trustees of the corporation may, by majority vote thereof present and voting, adopt amendments to these Articles of Incorporation.




