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

Exceeding Expectations Youth Foundation, Inc. ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION A non-profit Organization

Executed by the undersigned for the purpose of forming a Florida non-profit corporation under Chapter 617 Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I Name

The name of this corporation shall be: Exceeding Expectations Youth Foundation Inc.

ARTICLE II Address and Registered Agent

The name of the corporation's initial Registered Agent is:

ARTICLE III Purpose

Exceeding Expectations Youth Foundation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Exceeding Expectations Youth Foundation is organized to establish and operate a compilation of programs that tackle today's most vital youth issues for youth ages eleven (11) through eighteen (18) years of age. Programs are designed to encourage participants to take risks and comprehend physical, intellectual and emotional challenges. Major programs address educational needs, personal growth, life skills, and sportsmanship.

ARTICLE IV LIMITATIONS/RESTRICTIONS

At all times the following shall operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the corporation:

1. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to any member of the corporation not qualifying as exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, nor to any Director or officer of the corporation, nor to any other private persons, excepting solely such reasonable compensation that the corporation shall pay for services actually rendered to the corporation, or

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allowed by the corporation as a reasonable allowance for authorized expenditures incurred on behalf of the corporation;

- 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office; and
- 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended.
- 4. The corporation shall not lend any of its assets to any officer or director of this corporation [unless such loan program is regularly conducted as part of the activities of the organization and the qualification of the individual to participate in same is determined by a panel comprised solely of non-Board members!!], or guarantee to any person the payment of a loan by an officer or director of this corporation.

ARTICLE V INITIAL DIRECTORS/MEMBERS

The Corporation may (but need not) have a voting membership, and such membership, if any, and classes thereof, shall be as defined in the corporation's bylaws. The management and affairs of the Corporation shall be at all times under the direction of a Board of Directors, whose operations in governing the Corporation shall be defined by statute and by the Corporation's by-laws. No Member or Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the Corporation. The eligibility, rights and obligations of the Members will be determined by the organization's bylaws. The management of the affairs of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined by statute and by the Corporation's by-laws. No Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the Corporation. The number of Directors of the initial Board of Directors shall consist of a minimum of four (4), their names and addresses are as follows:

Members of the initial Board of Directors shall serve until the first annual meeting, at which their successors will be duly elected and qualified, or removed as provided in the bylaws.

ARTICLE VI DEBT OBLIGATIONS AND PERSONAL LIABILITY

No Member, Officer or Director of this Corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the Members, Officers or Directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this Corporation.

ARTICLE VII DURATION/DISSOLUTION

The duration of the corporate existence shall be perpetual until dissolution. Upon the time of dissolution of Exceeding Expectations Youth Foundation, assets shall be distributed by the Board of Directors, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all debts, obligations, liabilities, costs and expenses of the corporation, for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
