ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF A FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Faith Life Academy Inc.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 2407 E Graves Ave, Orange City, FL 32763.

ARTICLE III

CORPORATE PURPOSES: POWERS

The purpose for which the Corporation is organized and operated is exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code.

As a means of accomplishing the above purposes and methods, the Corporation shall have the following powers:

- (A) To receive and accept gifts of money and property and to hold the same for any of the purposes of the Corporation and its work.
- (B) To raise and assist in raising funds for the purposes herein set forth, including the issuance of bonds or other instruments of credit.
- (C) To acquire, own, lease, mortgage and dispose of property both real and personal.
- (D) To conduct and carry on religious and educational instruction through the public media, including electronic broadcasting, AM and FM radio, telecasting, microwave distribution, closed circuit transmission, and cable television.
- (E) To accept property and donations in trust for religious or charitable purposes.

(F) To acquire, hold, own, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock, bonds, obligations or other securities of other corporations, domestic, or foreign, as investment or otherwise, in carrying out any of the purposes of the Corporation and, while the owner thereof, to exercise all rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the power to vote thereon.

The property of the Corporation is irrevocable dedicated to religious, educational and charitable purposes, and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private personas, except that the corporation/organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf or, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

The Corporation shall not:

- (A) Operate for the purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit;
- (B) Accumulate income, invest income, or divert income, in a manner endangering its exempt status; or
- (C) Except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activity or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IV

MANNER OF ELECTION

The provisions of the Bylaws of the Corporation shall govern the manner in which the Directors of the Corporation shall be elected or appointed.

This Corporation is organized under a non-stock basis.

ARTICLE X

MEMBERS

This Corporation shall have members and they shall be admitted and qualified in accordance with the Bylaws adopted by the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE XI

AMENDMENTS

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be adopted by a majority of the trustees in the manner set forth in the Bylaws of this Corporation.

ARTICLE XII

MISCELLANEOUS

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities nor permitted to be carried on:

- (1) By a Corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or
- (2) By a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

Upon dissolution of this Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

Having been named as Registered Agent to accept service of process for the above stated corporation at the place designated in this certificate, I am familiar with and accept the appointment as Registered Agent and agree to act in this capacity.
