ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE PANAMA CITY BEACH LIBRARY FOUNDATION, INC.

(A Corporation Not For Profit)

The undersigned, desiring to form a Not-For-Profit Corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I Name of Corporation

The name of the Corporation shall be THE PANAMA CITY BEACH LIBRARY FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II Duration

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III Registered Office of the Corporation and Registered Agent

The principal office of the Corporation is to be located at 12500 Hutchison Boulevard, Panama City Beach, FL 32407 and the registered agent at that office is Patsy Duran.

ARTICLE IV Purposes of Corporation

The purposes of the Corporation are to support the Panama City Beach Library, a branch of the Bay County Public Library and a member of the Northwest Regional Library System. Such support shall include, but not be limited to, the promotion of the functions, resources, services and satisfaction of the needs of the library, the development of such, and the attraction and encouragement of gifts of funds, books, and art objects as may be appropriate and helpful.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section or any future federal tax code. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the Article hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170(C)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue

Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, as the Board of Directors shall determine to be for the welfare of the Greater Bay County and northwest Florida library system, and consistent with the purposes of the Corporation.

ARTICLE V Board of Directors

The number of directors constituting the Board of Directors of the Corporation from time to time shall be no fewer than five (5) and no more than twenty five (25). The number of directors of the Corporation may be changed by amendment to the By-Laws of the Corporation, but shall never be fewer than five (5). All Directors shall be elected by the members as provided in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VI Initial Directors of the Corporation

vested independently in the Board of Directors as provided in the By-Laws.
