

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FLORIDA NON PROFIT CORPORATION

#### **ARTICLE I**

The name of this corporation is: EDUCATION FIRST FOUNDATION, INC.

#### **ARTICLE II**

The principal office or mailing address of the corporation is 3939 NW 19th STREET LAUDERDALE LAKES, FLORIDA 33311

#### ARTICLE III

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, social and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law (the Code) and is not formed for pecuniary or financial gain. The Corporation is authorized to perform any Lawful activity for which corporations not-for-profit may be formed under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act. Not withstanding any other provisions of these articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not have or exercise ay power which would cause it not to qualify as a tax—exempt organization under section 501(C)(3) of the code; nor shall the Corporation engage directly or indirectly in any activity which will cause the loss of such qualification.

#### ARTICLE IV

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

#### ARTICLE V

The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- A. For the advancement of charity, education and any other related or corresponding charitable purposes by the distribution of its funds for such purposes.
- B. Specifically, the foundation shall accomplish charitable work in the area of education, health care, and housing domestically and internationally.

#### ARTICLE VI

The members of the corporation shall consist of the individuals constituting the Board of Directors hereinafter provided, and their successors in office. The qualification for membership in the Corporation may be modified as provided in the Bylaws.

#### **ARTICLE VII**

The number of Directors constituting the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be as provided in the Bylaws, provided, however the number of Directors shall not be less than three (3). The manner in which the Directors are to be elected or appointed as stated in the Bylaws of the Corporation. The

#### ARTICLE VIII

The officers and their manner of election shall be as provided in the Bylaws. The initial persons who are to serve as officers of the Corporation until the first meeting of the Board of Directors or until their successors are elected are:

#### ARTICLE IX

The business of the Corporation shall be managed by the Directors and the officers in accordance with the Bylaws. The officers of the Corporation shall be appointed from time to time by the boards of Directors. The officers shall serve at the pleasure of the board of Directors. The officers of the corporation shall be the President, Vice President, and Secretary. Treasurer and Executive Director. Any person may hold two or more offices except that the President shall not be the Secretary.

#### ARTICLE X

#### ARTICLE XI

Upon the liquidation or dissolution of the Corporation, its assets, if any, remaining after payment ( or provision for payment) of all liabilities of the Corporation, shall be distributed to one or more organizations qualified as exempt under section 501( c)(3) of the Code.

#### ARTICLE XII

Section 1. Prohibition on Private Inurement. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the of these Articles to the contrary, no part of the net earnings, current or accumulated, or property of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, any member (other than a member which is exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the code), director, officer, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services actually rendered and to make payment and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles

Section 2. Prohibition on Dividends. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the Contrary, the Corporation shall not have the power to declare dividends.

Section 3. <u>Limitation on Lobbying Activities</u>. Notwithstanding other provision of these Articles to the contrary, no substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.

#### Section 4. Prohibition on Intervening in Political Campaigns.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Section 5. Tax-Exempt Status. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the Contrary, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Code, or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under sections 170 (c)(2), 2055 (a)(2), and 2522(a)(2) of the Code.

#### ARTICLE XIII

Title to all property of the corporation shall be held in the name of the corporation or as otherwise may be provided pursuant to the authority of thee Bylaws of the Corporation. Any gift, bequest, devise or donation of any kind whatsoever to the Corporation or its Board of Directors shall be deemed to vest title in the Corporation.

#### ARTICLE XIV

The Corporation shall indemnify any officer, director or employee, or any former officer, director or former employee, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
