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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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The undersigned incorporator for the purpose of forming a Florida not-for profit corporation, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

**ARTICLE 1: CORPORATE NAME:** The name of this corporation is **LOVING WORLD FOUNDATION, INC.**

**ARTICLE 2: PRINCIPAL OFFICE:** The street address of the initial principal office and the initial mailing address of this corporation is 5168 Pine Grove Dr., West Palm Beach, FL 33417.

**ARTICLE 3: PURPOSE:** The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized and shall be operated are exclusively for charitable purposes, including, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article. No part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or participating in, or intervening in ( including the publication or distribution of statements, ) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

**ARTICLE 4: DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION:** Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

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**ARTICLE 5: DIRECTORS:** This Corporation shall elect or appoint directors as set forth in the Bylaws: provided, however, that there shall at all times be a minimum of three (3) directors. 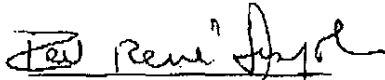

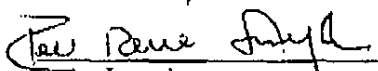
