ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

Bhakti Yoga Club, Inc.

A Florida "Not for Profit" Corporation

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under Chapter 617 of Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I. NAME

The name of the Corporation not for profit shall be Bhakti Yoga Club, Inc. ("Corporation").

Article II. DURATION

The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

Article III. PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal office of the Corporation is located at 1323 Nylic Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32304-2135. The same address shall serve as the Corporation's mailing address.

Article IV. PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and consist of the following:

- 1. To aid in the enrichment of the community through promotion of personal wellness and engagement in other civic activities, no part of which is intended to intervene in public campaigns, carry on propaganda, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation.
- 2. None of the net earnings from any of these community-enriching activities, whether in the form of donations, gifts, or other contributions, shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual.
- 3. To do any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, or desirable for the furtherance, accomplishment, or attainment of the foregoing purposes, either directly or indirectly, and either alone or in conjunction or cooperation with others, whether such others be persons or organizations of any kind or nature, such as corporations, firms, associations, trusts, institutions, foundations, or governmental bureaus, departments, or agencies.
- 4. All of the foregoing purposes shall be exercised exclusively for charitable and educational purposes in such a manner that the Corporation will qualify as an exempt organization under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

LETARY OF STATE ONS IN OF CORPORATIONS

Article V. ELECTION OF CORPORATE DIRECTORS

The directors of the Corporation shall be elected in accordance with methods and qualifications specified in the bylaws of the Corporation. In no event shall the number of directors be fewer than three.

Article VI. POWERS AND LIMITATIONS

The Powers of the Corporation shall be provided in the bylaws and shall be in accordance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. Additionally, the powers shall have the following limitations:

- 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal and state income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- 2. The Corporation is not organized nor shall it be operated for the primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit. The Corporation shall not distribute any gains, profits or dividends to the Directors, Officers, or Members thereof, or to any individual, except as reasonable compensation for services actually performed in carrying out the Corporation's charitable and educational purposes. The property, assets, profits, and net income of the Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes no part of which shall inure to the benefit of any individual.
- 3. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 4. Only an insubstantial amount of the activities of the Corporation shall be in furtherance of a purpose not set forth in Article IV.

Article VI. DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the assets of the Corporation remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to an organization recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to be used exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. If the Corporation holds any assets in trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such a manner as may be directed by decree of the Circuit Court of the district in which the Corporation's principal office is located, upon petition thereof by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.
