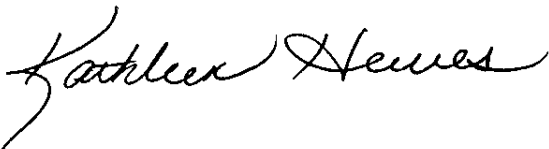

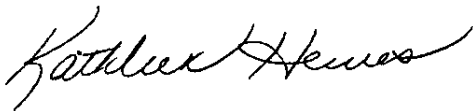

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Pursuant to the provision of the Nonprofit Corporation Act of the State of Florida, the undersigned incorporators hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1

The name of this corporation is: DELAND WOMEN'S ORGANIZATION, INC.

Article 2

The name and address of the registered agent and registered office of this corporation: is Rachel Sieg, PO Box 3056, DeLand, FL 32724. The principal place of business address is: 1731 Langley Ave., DeLand, FL 32724.

Article 3

The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are: This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes: To contribute to the civic improvement of the DeLand and West Volusia area by promoting the welfare of adults and children needing assistance, specifically, but not limited to scholarships for West Volusia women, to help women who are victims of domestic violence; to provide food and/or clothing to other organizations such as the Neighborhood Center, Second Harvest Food Bank and the Domestic Abuse Council; to provide education to the community on subjects which will help them in their day to day lives. These goals are accomplished through various fundraising activities, free lectures, and any and all other appropriate means.

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article 4

The number of initial directors of this corporation is four (4): Their names and address are as follows:

V President – Maria Jones, 515 W Wisconsin Ave., DeLand, FL 32720

Secretary – Robyn Harrington Schmidt, 935 Woodside Dr., Deland, FL 32720

Treasurer – Phyllis Matthesen, 2474 Marsh Road, DeLand, FL 32724

Article 5

The names and address of the registered agent of this corporation are:

Rachel Sieg, 1731 Langley Ave., Deland FL 32724

Article 6

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

Article VII

The classes, rights, privileges, qualifications and obligations of members of this corporation are as follows: This Corporation shall have one class of membership. Any person shall be qualified to become a member upon payment of the initial dues and shall continue as a member upon paying the annual dues. The amount, method, and time of payment of dues shall be determined, and may be changed, from time to time, by the board of directors. Additional provisions specifying the rights and obligations of members shall be contained in the bylaws of this corporation pursuant to, and in accordance with, the laws of this state.

Article VIII

Upon dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section

501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

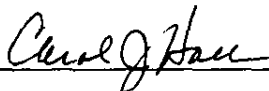
