Articles of Incorporation of

Chaplains College of Pastoral Ministry, Inc.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The business activity for said organization is as follows: The organization believes that education is important and preparing men and women for ordination and service. Some people cannot afford a full time college program due to their work schedule. All of our academic programs are practical and affordable. We are a ministry that believes that preparing ministers for Christ is important. Our goal is to send workers out to the field while the harvest is plentiful. At this organization you work at home at your own pace. The organization is the foremost leader of scholarly pursuit through online education. Consistent with our lofty standards, we are proud to offer our students a rich and rewarding route toward obtaining a Diploma or an Associate Degree in Pastoral Ministry.
