Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The business activity for said organization is as follows: The organization believes that education is important and preparing men and women for ordination and service. Some people cannot afford a full time college program due to their work schedule. All of our academic programs are practical and affordable.
