## Islamic Society of South Tampa Statement of Notarized Facts

We, the undersigned trustees of the Islamic Society of South Tampa, hereby file this statement of Notarized Facts regarding the management of the Islamic Society of South Tampa, Inc. A Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Document Number N10000009426.

The Islamic Society of South Tampa, Inc. ("ISST") filed a lawsuit against Mr. Mahmoud Kaheel, who was one of the founders of ISST. The Complaint included counts for Accounting and Declaratory Relief and Injunction and was case number 17-CA-5739. On August 7, 2020, the ISST and Mr. Kaheel attended a trial in front of the Honorable Stephen Scott Stevens, in the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit in and for Hillsborough County, Florida. After hearing all the testimony and evidence, Judge Stephens entered an order on October 23, 2020 that <u>permanently enjoined</u> Mr. Kaheel "from purporting to act as its [ISST] principal, owner, or agent, without first obtaining authority pursuant to the incorporating documents." See attached Order.

Mr. Kaheel has appealed this order and the appeal is currently pending in the Second District Court of Appeals. (Appellate case no. 2D20-3278)

While the case is on appeal, Judge Stevens order is binding on the parties, yet despite the clear order, Mr. Kaheel filed an annual report with the Division of Corporations, on January 19, 2021 wherein he lists himself as Director and Trustee, in direct violation of the Order.

The Division of Corporations should not accept any further filings from Mr. Kaheel (unless the appellate court reverses Judge Stevens Order) and the only authorized annual report was filed on Jan 15, 2021 by the undersigned trustees of ISST.

We swear, under penalty of perjury, that the foregoing facts are true and correct.


