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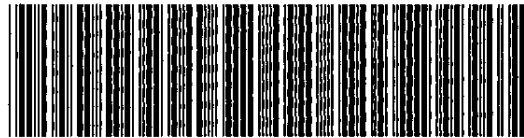

Articles of Incorporation

ARTICLE III, Purpose

Clewiston Multi-Generational Community Center, Inc., is organized to receive and administer funds and operates exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code (the "Code"), and in particular;

The purpose of Clewiston Multi-Generational Community Center, Inc., is to provide program and activities in Clewiston, Florida and the surrounding communities. The Center will focus on recreational, social, educational and cultural programs and activities for school age children, teenagers, adults and senior citizens.

ARTICLE IV, Manner of Election

The initial Directors are appointed by the incorporators. Directors shall be elected by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of Directors at its annual meeting. Vacancies occurring in the Board of Directors by reason of death, resignation, removal or other inability to serve shall be filled by the affirmative vote of a majority of the remaining directors. ARTICLE X, Dissolution and Disposition of Corporate Assets

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as such court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

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
