ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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OF

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CATHEDRAL OF FAITH CHURCH OF GOD IN CHRIST OF CE. FLORIDA TALLAHASSEE FLORIDA, INC.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is:

CATHEDRAL OF FAITH CHURCH OF GOD IN CHRIST OF TALLAHASSEE Florida, INC

ARTICLE II

DURATION

The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual, unless dissolved according to law. Corporation existence shall commence upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III

CORPORATE PURPOSE; POWERS

This Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable and educational purpose within the meaning of Section (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the 1986, as amended, or any superseding statute thereto, and such purpose shall include the following.

- (a) Religious
- (b) Conducting a local church by the direction of the Lord Jesus Christ And under the leadership of the Holy Spirit in accordance with all of the Commandments and provisions as set forth in the Holy Bible, the irrevocable Word of God. Pursuant thereto, the following activities and guidelines shall be implemented, adopted or established.

- A recognized creed, code of doctrine, discipline and form of worship to established.
- ii. An ecclesiastical form of government shall be established.
- iii. Ordination of ministers upon completion of the prescribed course of study, designated by the Church Of God In Christ Inc.
- iv. An organization of ministers shall be established to minister to the congregation of the Church.
- v. A Church membership shall be established based upon acceptance of a recognized creed and belief and support of the Church.
- vi. The Word of the Gospel shall be spread through seminars, radio, television, distribution of Church literature, and the use of other form of mass media for the purpose of educating the individual in the Word of God.
- vii. Various religious services shall be established pursuant to the recognized creed, form of worship, code of doctrine and discipline of the Church and school for religious and educational instruction for the young and old shall be established.
- viii. A school for the preparation of ministers who minister to the Church shall be established.
- (c) Ministering the Word of God to the Faithful
- (d) Promoting and encouraging, through the ministry of the organization, cooperation with other organizations. Ministering within the community.
- (e) Acquiring and holding such property, either real or personal, for Church purpose, as may be necessary for its membership and the worship of God.
- 2. As a mean of accomplishing the above purpose and methods, the corporation shall have the following powers:

- (a) To receive and accept gift of money and property and to hold the same for any of the purposes of the Corporation and its work.
- (b) To raise and assist in raising funds for the purposes herein set forth, including the issuance of the bonds or other instruments of credit.
- (c) To acquire, own lease mortgage and dispose of property, both real and personal.
- (d) To conduct and carry on religious services and instruction through the public media, including electronic broadcasting, AM and FM radio, telecasting, microwave distribution, closed circuit transmission, and cable television.
- (e) To accept property and donations in trust for religious or charitable purposes.
- (f) To acquire, hold, own sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock, bonds, obligations or other securities of other corporation, domestic, or foreign, as investments or otherwise, carrying out any of the purpose of the Corporation and, while the owner thereof, to exercise all right, power and privileges of ownership, including the power to vote thereon.
- (g) To license, ordain, and set froth ministers, pastors, evangelists, singers, and musicians in the ministry to provide training, counseling and education services necessary for the ministry, provided they are recommended by the Church's Pastor and complete a training program set froth or suggested by the Pastor.
- (h) To affiliate with and establish Church and schools.

In the conduct of the affairs of the Corporation:

- (a) The property of the Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious, educational and charitable purpose, and no part of the net earning of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to it and to make payment and distribution in furtherance of the purpose set forth in the Articles.
- (b) No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation; nor shall it in any manner or to any extent participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statement) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office; nor shall the Corporation engage in any activities that are unlawful under applicable federal, state or local law.
- (c) The Corporation shall not;
 - (1) operate for the purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit;
 - (2) accumulate income, invest income, or divert income, in a manner endangering its exempt status; or
 - (3) Except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activity or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purpose of the Corporation.
- (d) The Corporation's operation are to be conducted principally in the United State of America; the Corporation also may conduct operations in foreign countries, subject, however, to the law of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV

MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

The powers of the corporation shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and internal affairs of the corporation shall be regulated by, board of director which shall have three (3) directors initially. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by a majority of the directors, but at no time shall there be fewer than (3) directors of the Corporation.
